PROGRAM OF STUDY

Practical Theology Degree

You do not have to be working on any Ministerial Credentials to take the School of Ministry classes. The South Carolina Conference School of Ministry also partners with Advantage College to administer degrees in Practical Theology.

After completion of all three years a person can earn an Associates of Arts in Practical Theology from Advantage College.

Advantage College Fees

Ministerial Credentials

Local Ministers Certificate

In year one a student can take selected courses to meet the academic requirements for a Local Ministers Certificate. Note: these classes are marked with a * under Courses Of Study.

Ministerial License

After the first year a student will have met all of the academic requirements for Ministerial License in the International Pentecostal Holiness Church.

Ordination

After completion of years one, two, and three a student will have met all the academic requirements for Ordination in the International Pentecostal Holiness Church.

Continuing Education Credits

Students who already have Ministerial Credentials will receive 1.5 CEU's for each class attended.
