Option 1 | March 3

WebBuilder

If you have little computer skills and desire to build a very simple but functional website for your Church or ministry, the WebBuilder class on March 3, is a good choice. This is a very basic builder that yields amazing results that will work on desktops, tablets and smartphones.

Option 2 | March 10

WordPress

The March 10th class will incorporate WordPress. WordPress is the most popular CMS in the world and is used by nearly 75 million websites, that is 26.4% of the Web. WordPress is a little more complex than **WebBuilder**. **Don't** worry, I will make it simple, plus, there are tons of YouTube videos on how to use it.

No programming, code, HTML or CSS is needed for either class. Both builders are based on a drag-in-drop system that can be accessed from any desktop or laptop with internet connection.

These workshops aren't just for Churches, if you are a minister and want to build a website for your ministry, you are invited to attend.

After you sign up for the class, I will send you some information to fill out. If you do not have a domain, or hosting plan, give me a call (803-718-8786) **ahead of time so I can assist you...this is very important!**

If you secure a domain and hosting before the class, you will be able to work on a website during the workshop. If your church has a domain, but has never built a site, or you feel like it is costing too much money, give me a call. I am here to assist you. Refreshments will be provided.
